We recognize that:

- 1. The climate emergency demands immediate action to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and limit global temperature increases, in line with the goals of the Paris Agreement.
- 2. The energy transition is essential to promote sustainable, inclusive, and resilient economic development, benefiting all communities, especially the most vulnerable.
- 3. Technological innovation and investment in renewable energies, including emerging solutions like green hydrogen, are key drivers for advancing towards cleaner and more efficient energy systems.
- 4. International and regional collaboration is vital to share knowledge, resources, and experiences that accelerate the adoption of sustainable energy solutions and the diversification of energy sources.

We commit to:

- Promoting renewable energy: Driving the development and implementation of clean energy sources such as solar, wind, hydroelectric, and biomass, while exploring the strategic potential of technologies like green hydrogen.
- 2. **Fostering energy efficiency:** Implementing practices and technologies to optimize energy use across sectors, reducing waste and improving productivity.
- 3. **Supporting innovation and education:** Investing in research, development, and professional training to create green jobs and expand access to advanced technologies.
- 4. **Ensuring a just transition:** Ensuring that the shift to sustainable energy is inclusive and equitable, providing support and opportunities for affected communities and workers.
- 5. **Establishing comprehensive policies:** Collaborating with governments and policymakers to create regulatory frameworks that facilitate investments in sustainable energy infrastructure, including green hydrogen.
- 6. **Strengthening regional cooperation:** Working closely with neighboring countries and international organizations to address common challenges and enhance shared initiatives in the energy transition.

- Governments to set ambitious goals and clear policies that encourage energy transition and protect the
 environment.
- **The private sector** to invest in clean technologies and adopt sustainable practices, exploring innovative solutions like green hydrogen.
- Financial institutions to increase funding for renewable energy and energy efficiency projects.
- **Civil society and local communities** to actively participate in decision-making and promote sustainable practices in their areas.
- International organizations to support and facilitate global collaboration and knowledge exchange.
